### Job Posting: Contract Mental Health Therapist

PBJ Connections is a non-profit that provides professional behavioral health care to children, adults and families through horses, counseling and nature. We are looking to add Masters level licensed therapists to our team (LSW or LPC minimum). We provide outpatient mental health counseling in Western Licking county in our offices, via telehealth and through Eagala-model equine-assisted psychotherapy (EAP). Certification in Eagala is a plus, but training on the job and support for certification is available.

We are looking for team members who are willing to work with children ages six and up with trauma-informed experience with an openness to working with groups. Up to full-time contract work is available. Clinical supervision is included. Pay scale \$36-\$80 per session, which may include groups. Must be willing to be a continuous learner.

- Provide affordable and accessible mental health services by lowering barriers for families.

#### Responsibilities for Mental Health Therapist

- Provide an array of outpatient mental health services to promote individualized patient care
- Conduct intakes, individual, group, and family therapy
- Provide mental health assessments, counseling, and referrals
- Complete and maintain documentation in a timely and accurate manner and according to Federal, State and organizational guidelines
- Attend monthly contractor meetings and group supervision

#### Qualifications for Mental Health Therapist

- Able to make professional evaluations, decisions, and recommendation for treatment planning and implementation
- Current practitioner license through the state's clinical therapy board (LISW or LPCC preferred)
- 3 years of experience in counseling or mental health services
- Eagala certification or a plan to obtain Eagala certification ([www.eagala.org](http://www.eagala.org))
- Able to work independently and as a positive member of a team
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Comfortable working with children, teens and adults
